
Attendance for the year currently stands at 96.1%. Please continue to keep school attendance in mind when you are booking your holidays.



The cake sale was a great success, thank you if you baked and thank you if you bought this raised £175.

Please keep checking your child's hair regularly so that we may reduce/remove the cases of headlice. Treating once is not enough, regular checks are necessary by everyone.


