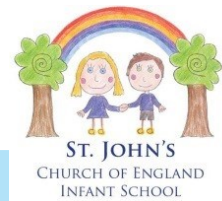

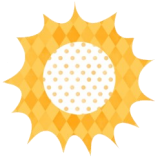
We reflected upon this and asked the question **"Are we doing small things with great love that we might be thanked for?"**

As we have learned over the past few years school, attendance is so very important for social reasons as well as educational development.

### Please note

A Headteacher may only grant leaves of absence in exceptional circumstances—a leave of absence for the purposes of a family holiday is not an exceptional circumstance.

You cannot plan for illness but you can plan for when to take your holidays. It may feel like only a small amount of time for a holiday but then if your child also becomes unwell during the same year they would be missing out on many more days. Following consideration, should you still require a leave of absence you must complete a form and submit it to the office.

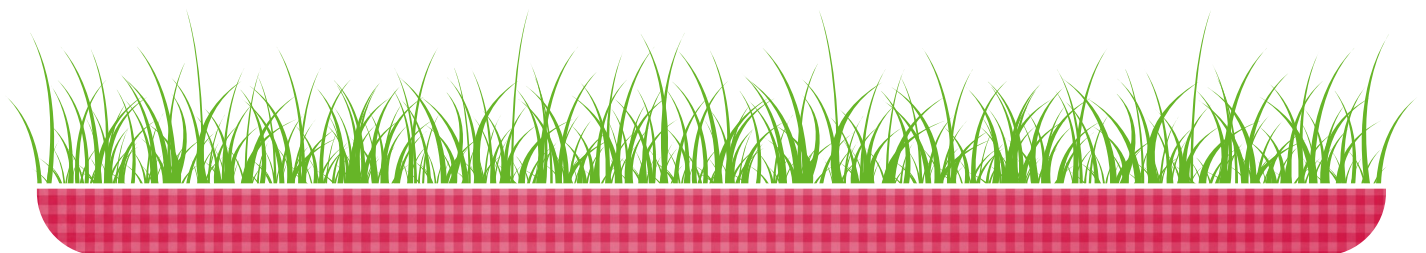
